Contract 2

Whereas,

wishes to buy, and

CAPRIKORN FARMS wishes to sell:

THE Saanen dairy goat(s) known as:

Here is their agreement:

1. Price is \$_____. Plus \$10 for every e-mail or phone call or fax you make after the 4th one.
2. The buyer will make a \$100 deposit for each animal. The deposit is refundable anytime the buyer changes their mind. There is no deal until the deposit arrives. For Saanens over 1,000, the deposit is TEN PERCENT (1/10TH) OF THE PRICE.
3. The buyer will pay all shipping costs, including any crates. The crate is refunded when the buyer sends it back. If your baby is flying our charge to the airport is \$80.
4. Shipping promptly at 30 days, which includes 21 days for pen breeding. If the buyer delays the shipping past that date then the buyer has to pay boarding of \$4.50 per day per dry animal, \$4 per day for milker. If the buyer doesn't want to pay boarding, they should notify the seller to send the deposit back.
5. Included in price we will/will not **mark thru one!** breed these goats.
6. The buyers DO have the right to TURN DOWN an animal.
7. The seller has insured the kids do not contract CAE. The seller does c.a.e test on the whole herd 2 and sometimes 3 times a year.
8. On a buck kid the seller will contact the buyer if there are any flaws. If the kid has a final score of Very Good from the Appraiser the seller may not have time to do this.
9. Any disputes to be resolved under the laws of the state of Maryland.
10. This contract is void if another deposit is received before the buyers.
11. The quoted price means right now. In future days/weeks/months/years the

sellers may change the price. When the deposit is received, the price is fixed. The Seller has to sell at that price for the next 30 days, no matter how much the animal goes up in value through DHI or show wins or whatever.

12. If your goat is pregnant when you buy it, and you bring it back for a full refund, then you have to bring all the kids back also.
13. Each animal must have been sired by the specified buck, not some other buck.
14. The buyer can return the animal for a complete refund of the purchase price anytime up to one year. In the case of a buck, minus 40 for each descendent. In the case of either a buck or doe, minus one-half without a Negative CAE test.
15. Other sellers charge you ADGA fees for registration papers, and then they remove the collars. Caprikorn Farms pays these things for you. But see item 17.
16. If the buyer reserves more than five animals and cancels, the first five deposits will be refunded immediately. But on the sixth and following animals \$4.50 per day boarding will be charged. Per number of days from 4 weeks after the deposit until the refund is requested. (During the time your deposit is down you have taken the goat off the market. Other buyers could not buy your Saanen. Our costs of raising your Saanen continue every day until the next buyer comes along.)
17. EXPORTS: If the buyer is outside the U.S., we have to deal with four U.S. Veterinarians plus whatever unusual laboratory tests the buyer's country requires. The export vet fees are part of your shipping costs. In addition there is a flat charge of \$295 U.S. for this, plus the USDA fee. We start the tests AFTER you have your import permit from your country. Tests which your country wants in addition to the usual brucellosis and TB are a small extra charge. Canada is an extra \$95. If the goat is flying, there is a charge to transport from the quarantine airport site to the plane. If there are too many export problems, the sellers may refund all of the monies they have received and cancel.
